Special Olympics

State Equestrian Meet in Huron, SD



On July 10th, 2023 some of our riders participated in the Equine Special Olympics at the state fairgrounds in Huron, SD. We were able to take 10 riders and 6 horses. Our riders competed in English Equitation and

Working Trail. English Equitation clients are judged on how they sit in the saddle, how they hold their reins and how well they control their horse at a walk and trot. They are also asked to back their horses. In English Equitation HorsePower riders received; 1 bronze, 4 silver and 5 gold medals! The Working Trail consists of riders moving their horse through an obstacle course. This year a few of the things the clients had to do were move rings from one pole to another, go over a bridge and move a bean bag from the mailbox to a bucket. Our medal count for Working Trail was; 3 bronze, 2 silver and 4 golds! In total our riders brought 4 bronze, 6 silver and 9 gold medals home! Max, a participant in this years Special Olympics, said his favorite part of the Special Olympics day was getting to trot and hanging out with everyone all day.

We are so proud of all the hard work these riders have put in over the summer. They all did so incredibly well. This day would not have been possible without the amazing help of our volunteers, thank you to all who came out to support our riders!!
